

Painted Parking Space

General Information

This year, SMA seniors will have the opportunity to paint and personalize their parking space on campus. The painted parking space will cost \$30 to cover the cost of painting it over at the end of the year. Seniors must complete this contract, submit their design, and have it approved prior to the painting days.

Please read over this information carefully with your parents.

When Can I Paint?

You may only paint your space during the following painting days: **Wed, Sept 9 3:30-8:00, Thurs, Sept 10 3:30-8:00, Saturday Sept 12 from 9:00-1:00.** Your contract and design must be submitted by **Tues, Sept 8, 2020** to Sr. Jude Andrew, OP.

If these days are rained out, we will publish new dates.

After the painting day, you may not alter or change your parking space.

What Can I Paint?

Think of your parking space as a T-shirt you would design and wear for school. Your parking space must meet all dress code guidelines. Keep it classy!

All designs must be approved by administration prior to your painting. Include a copy of your design with the contract, including colors. Your design should be fully sketched, including all text, symbols, and colors you plan to use. Make two copies of this design, and submit one with your contract. It will be kept on file in the office. On the painting day, you must follow your design exactly, no changes allowed. Failure to follow your design exactly will result in disciplinary action, including the painting over of your design if necessary.

Allowed Designs:

You may include your name, jersey number, instrument you play, hobby, Bible passages, famous quotes or slogans. Personalize your spot by creating a design that shows your school spirit, and reflects your interests and those things that are meaningful to you.

Not Allowed Designs:

Any design associated with gangs, drugs, alcohol, violence, political statements, obscene or offensive language, symbols, flags, or slogans will not be approved. There cannot be any gang-style tagging, double meanings, or nicknames or including of other peoples' names in your spot.

Note: Any prohibited items will be painted over at the student's expense at the discretion of the administration. The student will be responsible for the cost of the paint necessary. The registration fee will not be refunded. Disciplinary action may be taken, including the rescinding of the student parking space.

Where Can I Paint?

You may paint within your own parking space, leaving a 4 inch margin on all sides – 4 inches from the curb, 4 inches from both white lines, and 4 inches above your parking space number. Your parking space number must not be painted over or around.

What Type of Paint Can I Use?

You may ONLY use water based interior or exterior latex paint.

Unapproved Paints

- No oil based paint
- No reflective paint
- No spray paint
- No fluorescent paint
- No paint sprayers
- No clear coat
- No glitter

What Supplies Will I Need?

- Your approved design
- All paint brushes, rollers (and extensions), paint pans, and paint tape
- Drop cloth, paint clothes, towels, rags, trash bag
- A broom to sweep your space before painting (this will save you a lot of time!)
- Lawn chairs, towels, blankets to sit on
- An umbrella or canopy for shade
- Water and snacks
- Family and friends – recruit help and have fun!

Any Hints?

Yes! Paint can be expensive!

- Check to see if there is a place that will give away (or sell for a reduced price) recycled water based latex paint.
- Ask family, friends, grandparents if they have any paint (water based latex paint) that they are not using. You can get it tinted at a hardware store.
- Check the clearance section for custom colors that people have asked for, and then did not buy.
- Talk to you friends about what colors they are using, then go in together on the paint.
- Simplify your design. More colors = more money.

Get 4 inch wide painters tape to mark the edges of your design – remember, it needs to be 4 inches from the white lines, the curb, and above the parking space number.

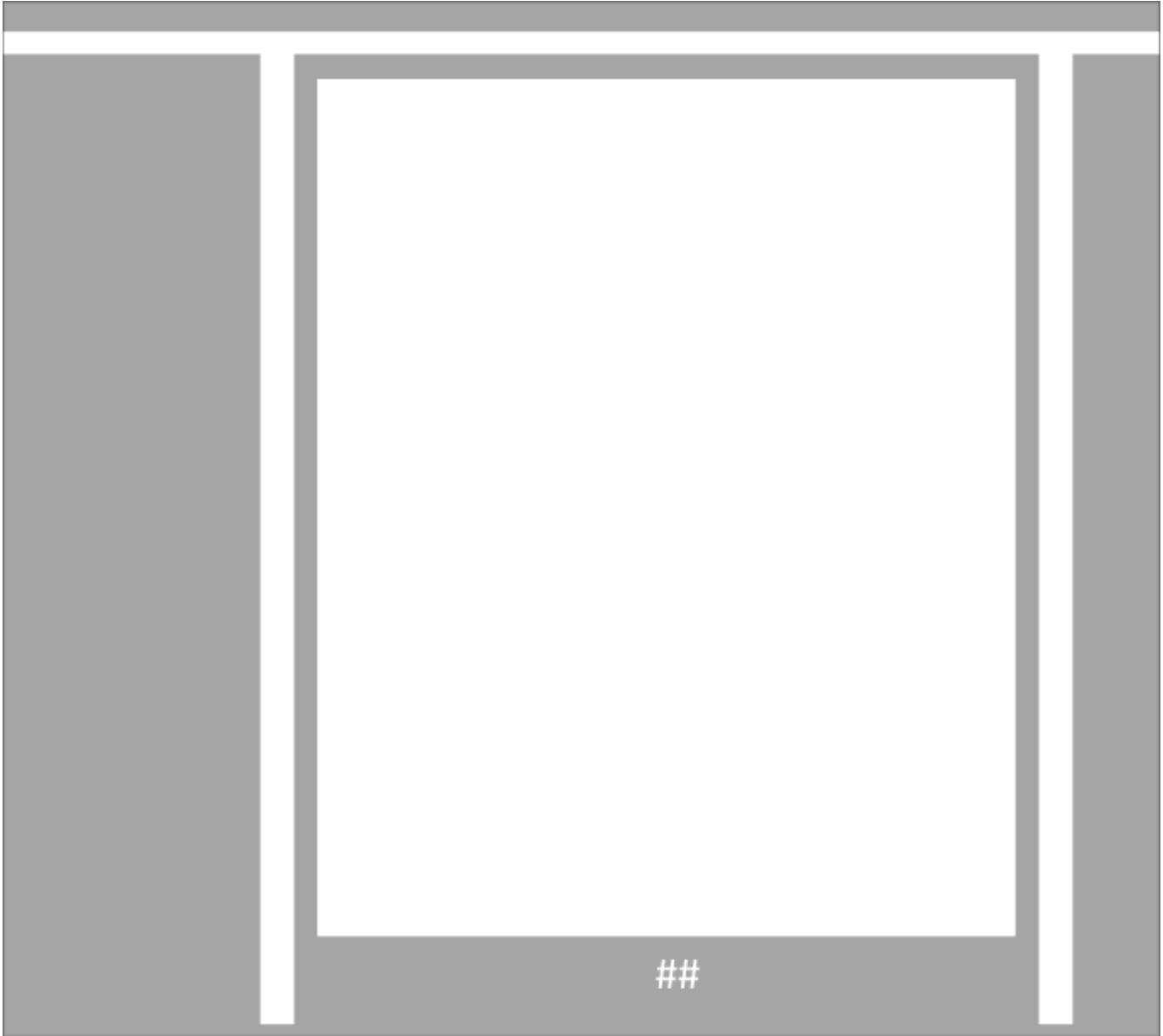
