We are so excited to have the students return to school this week! Great effort has been made to make our school as safe as possible for our students to return to in-person learning this week. If you have not done so, please take the time to review the information previously sent about the procedures in place during this time.

As Welcome Home and Orientation Days are upon us, please note the following:

ALL students MUST bring a signed COVID Liability Waiver with them to Orientation. The revised document must be signed even if one was completed to participate in summer activities. Please print and sign this document, [REVISED COVID-19 WAIVER](#).

ALL students MUST complete the SWAY App each morning prior to coming to school. Directions for setting up the APP can be found at [Student Sway App Instructions](#).

Yearbook and Student ID's pictures will be taken during Orientation on Wednesday and Thursday. For this reason, it is important that students are in uniform compliance, including hair, piercings, and facial hair. Please review the handbook for uniform expectations.

In an effort to practice the COVID necessary procedures, an additional Syllabus Day has been scheduled for Monday, August 31st. Students do not need to bring any supplies with them to Orientation, except maybe a water bottle. Freshmen and transfer students who have dropped off their laptops will receive them back at Orientation.
